This granite massif, the highest in Namibia, earns its name from the fiery glow that it casts at sunset, an ethereal blaze that sets the mountain alight in hues of crimson and gold.

Legend speaks of ancient spirits that dwell within Dâures; guardians of the sacred rock art hidden in its caves and crevices.

The mountain stands as a sentinel over the desert, a timeless monument that draws us nearer, like a moth to a flame. We keep our throttles pinned and our hearts at full swell.

From the elusive leopard and the hardy desert elephant, it is a land that invites you to lose yourself in its vastness, to ride its deserts and mountains, to uncover the secrets that lie in its remote corners.

DAILY ITINERARY

Day one:

Arrive at Walvis Bay airport and meet our team as we get you settled in at the Hotel, here we mingle over a few cold beers and chat about the epic journey that lies ahead. We provide a detailed overview of the tour itinerary, ensuring that you are well informed and prepared for the days ahead.

Day two:

The morning kicks off with a hearty breakfast overlooking the ocean. We eagerly catch the first glimpse of our sleds as they are lined up outside ready to rip. We dial in the bikes and depart from Walvis Bay, explore some Dunes on the way and enjoy the first few miles of dirt to Goanikontes. Spirits are high and we are hungry for adventure. Upon arrival, we settle into the lodge and exchange stories over dinner and beers.

Day three:

We head toward the Damaraland and on the way we marvel at one of Namibia's iconic landmarks, the majestic Spitzkoppe Mountain. From Goanikontes to the Erongo Mountains, the miles pass quickly, but the smiles last all day. Here we will camp at the base of the beautiful Erongo Rocks. The Moto Safari team will set up camp and have cold beers on ice. As we delve deeper into the desert, Wi-Fi and emails become a distant memory and we appreciate the silence and solitude the Namib Desert offers.

Day four:

We begin the day with a ride to a local village, where you can interact with Namibian Bushmen and gain insight to their ancient traditions. Our local guide will translate, so you can ask questions, making this experience even more incredible. After this epic encounter, we ride on to Omaruru, stopping at a famous locale on the way known for its homemade Namibian dishes. As we traverse the beautiful Erongo conservancy on our bikes, keep your eyes peeled for an array of wild animals like Oryx, Zebra, Kudu and Springbok. Upon arrival at our Lodge, we relax by the water hole before embarking on an afternoon game ride to see giraffes, elephants and white rhinos.

Day five:

We rise for an early start as we head west from Omaruru and ride towards the majestic Dâures— The Burning Mountain. Equipped with our capable KTM 500's we tackle jeep tracks, sandy riverbeds and rock gardens. Along the way, we'll have the opportunity to witness the local Himba tribes still proudly adorned in their traditional clothing. After a solid day of riding, we enjoy relaxing around the crystal blue swimming pool of our lodge. We take in the enormous landscapes and its views of the Majestic Burning Mountain— The Jewel of the hauntingly beautiful Damaraland. The evening concludes in a perfect way as we spot the desert elephants which are known to roam in these parts.

DAILY ITINERARY

Day six:

We wake up on day 6 to wild animals surrounding camp as we sip our morning coffee. So close you can almost touch them. We have a full day of epic riding and breathtaking scenery that awaits us as we head north to our Moto Safari signature lodge. We traverse the Mars landscape with throttles at full tilt as we cross the Ugab river into the Kunene region. The journey offers views and landscapes that burn into your retinas like golden daggers. Memories that will last a lifetime.

Day seven:

We start early to cover the distance to Cape Cross. We ride through the ancient Messum Crater, formed over 130 million years ago by volcanic activity, this vast caldera stretches across 18 kilometres, its rocky walls bearing the scars of cataclysmic eruptions that once reshaped the earth. The Messum Crater, an imposing amphitheatre of rugged basalt and granite, is a testament to the powerful forces that have shaped Namibia's terrain. Legend holds that this crater was forged by the fiery breath of a slumbering giant, whose wrath split the earth and left behind a hollow basin, now filled with the echoes of a turbulent past.

Day eight:

After a refreshing night, the cool sea breeze and the calming sound of crashing waves herald the start of the next leg of our adventure. Our journey begins at the Cape Cross seal colony, where you will have the opportunity to walk among Cape fur seals. Witnessing these fascinating creatures in their natural habitat is a truly unforgettable experience. As you marvel at the lively seal colony, take a moment to admire the historic cross erected by the Portuguese explorer, Diego Cao, in 1484, marking the first European to set foot in this remote region.

Leaving Cape Cross, we navigate the salt roads towards Henties Bay, where more excitement awaits. Here, you will traverse a long beach section, with the vast ocean on one side and the endless desert on the other, leading us to the hauntingly beautiful Zeila shipwreck. We close the trip with a last play in the Dunes and a few cold beers before heading to the hotel.

Day nine:

With heavy hearts and unforgettable memories, it's time to say goodbye to the Land that God Made in Anger. We shake hands, exchange hugs, and vow to do it all over again soon. Strangers are now friends memories are etched forever and we do our best to fight the post trip blues. Until next time.
